## **PARISH COUNCIL**

The Annual Parish Meeting was held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 21 May and commenced at 19.30.

The elected Chairperson is Councillor Adrian Brown and the elected Vice Chairperson Councillor Barbara Sleep. The Annual Report of the Parish Council and the Statement on the Parish Council accounts for the year ended 31 March 2014 were considered. There were a number of reports from the many organisations within the parish. Finally the official officers for the Lewannick Play Park and Polyphant Play Area put forward their reports for the year

Following the Annual Parish Meeting the Ordinary Meeting of Lewannick Parish Council was held. We are in the process of adopting a new agenda for our meetings. In essence if residents have any matters that they would like to draw to our attention we would ask them to contact the Clerk or any Councillor a week prior to our meeting. The matter will be incorporated in our agenda. There will be a public session when members of the public are invited to make comment or draw to the attention of the Council, any matters included in the agenda

During our Ordinary Meeting dated 21 May it was brought to our attention that there remains a number of potholes throughout the parish that merit urgent attention. We have again requested highways to process this.

Planning applications received were PA14/03034 Reserved Matters application for the construction of dementia units. It was resolved that the application would be supported as it is a nice location for a unit and this would finish it off.

PA14/01736 Application for fell one Oak tree subject to a Tree Preservation Order, October, Medrow, Polyphant, Launceston - Mrs Iris Curley. The tree had been left unsightly following work that had been carried out by an Electrician. It was, therefore, resolved to support the application.

We have received a number of complaints from residents about the disruption and disturbance that a party over the weekend 2 to 5 May had caused in Polyphant and have written to the owner of the field and organiser of the party.

Our Annual General Meeting was held at Lewannick Hall because the yearly meeting had been held at Polyphant the previous year. Our ordinary meeting is, however, scheduled to take place at Lewannick on Wednesday June 18. The meeting will commence at 20.00 hours. If any residents have matters that they would like to be discussed please let us know so that they can be inserted into our agenda.
