PARISH COUNCIL

Lewannick Parish Council held two meetings during June. An Extraordinary Meeting was held on Wednesday 11 June in order to finalise our considerations on the housing register.

We also went through tenders for Polyphant Green. The tender has been awarded to Nathan Pearson who, as we go to print, as begun the cutting and raking of the conservation area in order to promote wildflowers and stronger grass.

Our Ordinary Meeting was again held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 18 June 2014 and commenced at 20.00 hours.

Planning applications for decision were:-

PA14/04555 Erection of eight new low energy eco-dwellings Land opposite Cottage Gardens, Lewannick, Launceston, Cornwall for Mr Liam Halloran. We have objected to the application. There is insufficient infrastructure and the development would be built on a junction with many hazards. The development is being built next to existing bungalows which will have a serious impact on their privacy, light and amenity.

PA14/02919 Outline Application for erection of two buildings land North of Glebelands, Old Hill, Mr and Mrs White. We have supported this application in principle. We have requested a Section 106 to be attached.

PA14/04641 The Warren, Polyphant, Launceston, Cornwall, PL15 7PS.

Application to fell a single conifer in a Conservation Area - the application has been supported.

Children's Health and Wellbeing Services Review - our considerations were put forward.

NATIONAL SCAM

We have received the following information from Devon and Cornwall Police, that you may find useful. There is a national scam that is attempting to defraud people, many who are vulnerable due to age, out of thousands of pounds. The offenders are tending to exhaust opportunities in one particular area of the country before moving onto another.

The offenders call victims purporting to be police officers from the MET and are investigating a crime relating to fraudulent activity on the victims bank account. They then convince the victim to either transfer their savings into another bank account or they obtain their bank details allowing them to withdraw money.

The initial action to take is to Ring 101 and inform the Devon and Cornwall Police. Dial 1471 from your landline - this may reveal the caller's number if the last call received was from the offender(s). If you make a phone call following a suspect call, make sure you hear the normal dialling tone before you dial. A hoax caller can hold onto the line and pretend to be an official and encourage you to give away confidential information before you realise it.
