Lewannick Parish Council

Met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 16 July. The meeting commenced at 20.00 hours. We were pleased that some of the pot holes within our parish have now been filled in, however, there are still areas that require attention. The vegetation overgrowth from Examples Cross to Trevadlock and by Trevadlock Hall Park has been cut back. At the time of writing we are in communication with Highways and our County Councillor with reference to a site meeting with respect to further pot holes that require urgent attention. Concerns have been raised with respect to the condition of the pavements at Hawks Tor, road safety issues from Beacon View to Lewannick Primary School and finally how to alleviate parking problems at Cottage Gardens. Again we are in communication with Highways and our County Councillor.

Dog fouling appears to be escalating within the parish. This is not because of inadequate dog bins which are well placed throughout the parish. Nevertheless, it has become apparent that a number of dog walkers are not using them. Indeed, they appear to throw plastic bags with the offending material into the hedges rather than use the bins. There is also considerable fouling near the school. We have requested the regular presence of the Dog Warden to patrol the location throughout the summer period. **Planning applications** for consideration comprised:-

PA14/05792 Installation of septic tank land south of 20 Cottage Gardens, Lewannick, RFL Developments: supported house being built, therefore, support septic tank installation. Other new build next to it also supported previously.

PA14/05791 Erection of garage to adjacent barn owned by client. Trelaske Barn, Lewannick, Launceston. Mr G Scott. Supported - added benefit to existing dwelling.

PA14/05706 Amendment to approved application **PA12/06694** to include change of cottage style dwelling from 2 bedrooms to 3 bedrooms. Trelaske Barton, Lewannick, Cornwall. Mr J W and T D White. Original application of 2 bedroom cottage had been supported. Additional bedroom is at the back of the building, out of view from the road - supported.

PA14/05910 Remove render from west facing wall to reveal the original stone to match the rest of house and repointing with lime mortar. Darkes Farm, Polyphant. Mr Simon Bird. Supported - added benefit to existing dwelling.

PA14/05659 Construction of a new single family dwelling with associated car parking bays to road frontage. Abovetown Bungalow at Pen-Inney Cottage, Lewannick. Mr David Eno. Original application was supported. Proposed dwelling is infill.
