Lewannick Parish Council

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant
village hall on 15th October. It was agreed that a
defibrillator will be purchased for Lewannick
through the Community Heart Beat Trust. Fund
raising has commenced. If you are interested in
donating there is a collection point at The
Archer Arms and the Village shop at Lewannick.

Why we are having a defibrillator? Following
a Cardiac Arrest the chance of survival
decreases by 23% per minute. It is very
important medical treatment starts as soon as
possible. The UK Resuscitation Council suggests
that an AED should be available where medical
treatment is more than 5 minutes away.

A grant of £350 has been awarded to
Launceston over 50's.

Invoices presented for payment comprised
Classic Garden Furniture £555 for a wooden
bench which will be located near the village hall
Lewannick and £180 for the printing of our
Newsletter (6 Months) from Launceston
Printing Company

Our budget for 2015/16 will be finalised
during our meeting in November which will be
held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday
19th November 20.00 hrs

St Martin's Church - Where have all the trees gone?

Most of you will have noticed that there has been a lot of work going on around St Martin's Church, most noticeable of which, has been the removal of several large trees. Last winter, a very large tree came down in South Petherwin churchyard, narrowly missing an adjacent property but severely damaging several memorials in the church yard. In order to prevent any occurrence in St Martin's, a tree survey was carried out and it was found that some of the trees were rotten and others, as a result of root growth, were undermining the wall surrounding the church. It was therefore agreed that the current trees should be removed to prevent any future damage to property or disruption due to road closure. On removing the trees, it was found that far more of the trees than originally thought were in a dangerous state.

The good news is we will be replanting, with native trees, which hopefully will last several generations and provide colour and shelter around the church.
