Lewannick Parish Council

held their ordinary meeting at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 18 March. The meeting commenced at 20.00 hours.

There were three planning applications for consideration, all of which were supported by Lewannick Parish Council, namely:

PA15/01437 Moor View, Old Hill, Lewannick, Launceston, to make an additional car parking space.

PA15/01291 Retention and completion of conversion of barn to a dwelling. Including an extension and garage (previously approved). Stables at Trelaske Manor, Lewannick.

PA15/01272 Sand School and change of use from agricultural to equestrian (no agricultural use of the land for 8 years).

Finance: Invoices for payment R Morley - cleaning bus shelters, Lewannick - £50.

Polyphant Methodist Church £49,00 for hiring of hall with respect to committee meetings and £14.00 hire of hall for defibrillator meetings.

Cornwall Council £570.00 tree safety inspections carried out on 18 December 2014.

We have had a site meeting with Highways with respect to Landers Lake, Lewannick and it is understood that work will commence shortly with respect to the flooding problems.

The speed of traffic through Lewannick was brought to the attention of the Council by concerned residents. The problem is particularly serious at school collection and drop off times. We urge everyone to have consideration and care when driving through the village.

There will be a further defibrillator training on Monday 20 April 7 - 9.

Our next ordinary meeting is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 15 April. The meeting will be held at Lewannick Village Hall commencing at 20.00 hours. Members of the public are welcome to attend.
