On Wednesday 20 May our meeting commenced at 19.30 at Polyphant Village Hall with our Annual Parish Meeting. This gave the various organisations within our parish an opportunity to put forward their reports for the year. Following our invitation to organisations within the parish our County Councillor, Chairperson and Financial Officer gave their reports for the year to 31 March 2015.

The Chairperson for the year 2015 - 16 was duly elected together with our Vice Chairperson. Councillor Barbara Sleep continues as our Chairperson and Councillor Paul Atkinson has been elected as our Vice Chairperson.

We have a vacancy on the parish council for a councillor following the resignation of Adrian Brown. Our Ordinary Meeting followed immediately after the Annual Parish Meeting.
