AONB Consultation. All councillors have gone through the consultation papers and our collective response has been submitted.

There was one **planning application** for discussion namely PA15/04804 Mr and Mrs J Harris. Two dwellings, the provision of private access and on-site parking on land east of the Sycamores, Lewannick. The application has been supported. It is our view that the application is in fill and that the design would suit the location.

FLY TIPPING - We are very concerned that, yet again, there has been a case of fly tipping off the A30 to Lewannick layby. Each time that fly tipping is collected costs the whole community. The site is now under surveillance. We would urge everyone to take note of any vehicles that are stopped at the location and depositing items.
