Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 17 February at 7pm.

Residents present raised their concerns with reference to the planning application for Blackhill Quarry - PA15/10051.

There were two planning applications for discussion, namely:-

1. PA16/00204 Sunnybank House, Polyphant, Mr A Haithwaite. Outline application (all matters reserved) for a proposed dwelling on land to side of Sunnybank House. The application was supported
2. PA16/00306 Works to trees covered by a TPO to 1 Sycamore and 2 beech trees, Lewannick Manor. The application was supported.

FINANCE Invoices for payment comprised:-

1. Lewannick Village Hall - for the hire of hall - £84.00
2. Nathan Pearson - for the removal of dangerous willow tree - £315.00 - Polyphant.
3. Illand Nurseries - for providing Christmas tree - £10.00.

A separate meeting has been scheduled for Monday 22 February at Lewannick 7pm in order for councillors to consult on the important issue of the Local Plan.
