Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick village hall on Wednesday 20 April. The meeting commenced at 19.00 hours.

BLACKHILL QUARRY Update on PA15/10051 Asphalt plant. We have confirmation that the number of jobs to be created is 2 not 7, as stated in the planning application. Cormac have also recently stated that all vehicles accessing the site from the east (Launceston) should turn off at Five Lanes underpass junction and rejoin the A30 at Two Bridges. They have also confirmed that they will import high psv stone from Ireland to the port at Falmouth.

POT HOLES We are constantly lobbying our Cornwall Councillor and Highways to repair the pot holes throughout our parish.

PLANNING PA16/01944 - Mr Roger Finimore - land at Trenhorne - supported.

PA16/02869 Demolish attached shippen and construct a two storey extension. Higher Trevell Farmhouse, Launceston. Mr and Mrs D Pickett - supported.

PA16/01432 change of use from a farmhouse to bed and breakfast accommodation and change of use from a function room to a restaurant.

Coombeshead Farm Road, Lewannick, Launceston, Coombeshead Farm Hotel Trading Limited. Supported.

PA16/02500 Domestic garage - Trelaske Cottage, Mr Gordon Scott. Not supported. Garage dimensions too big for size of dwelling.

PA16/02694 Barton Gate Stables, Trelaske Barton, Lewannick, Miss Kirsty White. This proposal is for an alternative design for the dwelling approved in applications PA12/06694 and PA14/05706.

Appeal ref PA15/10615 Mr and Mrs P G Grimshaw. Building 1. Blackberry Farm, Congdons Shop. Not supported. Building in countryside and property would be highly visible.
