Lewannick Parish Council

We held our Annual Parish Meeting at Polyphant on Wednesday 18 May. The meeting commenced at 19.00 hours. The Chairperson for 2016/17 elected - Mrs Barbara Sleep and Vice Chairperson - Paul Atkinson.

The annual reports were read out by the Chairperson and the Clerk reported on the Statement of accounts as at 31 March 2016.

Reports from organisations within the parish were also noted and read out.

The Chair thanked everyone for their attendance and to those organisations who had sent in reports.

Following the Annual Parish Meeting the Ordinary Meeting commenced.

It is noted that Blackhill Quarry PA15/10051 has been withdrawn by Cormac.

Vivian Hall our Cornwall Councillor was present at the meeting and confirmed that the pot holes within the parish were being given priority and should be filled very soon. We are in the process of installing telephone lines into Lewannick hall and Polyphant so that wi fi will be available at both sites.

Grant applications received were awarded to Polyphant Methodist Church £1,000 and Trevadlock Cemetary £500. Other payments were made to Aon for our annual insurance £442.94, Cornish and Devon Post £15.12 and Mr Colin Moore £450.

Cornwall Local Plan - Gypsy and Travelling Communities Site allocations development plan document, which had been previously circulated to members, was considered. It was agreed that there was no evidence based for the requirement of a site within our parish.

Our next meeting will take place at Lewannick on Wednesday 15 June commencing 19.00 hours. Members of the public are always welcome to attend.
