Lewannick Parish Council

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant village hall on Wednesday 20 July. The meeting commenced at 19.00 hours and was open to the public and the press.

Co-option of councillors - we are pleased to confirm that there was a healthy interest from the community to take part in council affairs. The applicants who have been co-opted to the council are Sue Driscoll, Polyphant and Roger Finnimore who lives in Lewannick.

Planning applications - there were two planning applications for discussion, namely:-

PA16/06403 Mr and Mrs H Harris - which has been supported together with **PA16/05226** which has also been supported.

Invoices for payment included Mr Nathan Pearson for the maintenance of Polyphant Green including the filling of pot holes on the footpaths £2,170 Horizon replacing a broken pane of glass at Lewannick Bus Shelter £240 and Launceston Printing Company £180 for printing of monthly newsletter.

Lewannick Play Area - there are repairs being undertaken at the play area, namely to the zip wire. We have also instructed the cleaning of the equipment on a regular basis. We have also instructed the cleaning of the play equipment at Polyphant Play Area.

Plusha - Route strategies for England's motorways and trunk roads are prepared by Highways England. These strategies are one of the key steps of research required by the Department of Transport to help the Government develop the next Road Investment Strategy, which covers the period post-2020. The Road Investment Strategy will be the foundation for much of the thinking about where to invest in the strategic road network after 2020. Highways England has recently commenced the process of preparing the second round of Route Strategies, with the objective of publishing them in 2017. The issues and evidence gathering phase of the preparation of these Route Strategies has started and is open for YOU to get involved. If you want to report individual issues that affect you as a motorist on, or as a neighbour of, the strategic road network, we invite you to enter these via the online mapping tool. If you have datasets, models or mapped evidence, please email routestrategies@highwaysengland.co.uk

It is necessary to gather a comprehensive view of the performance, impact and challenges related to the strategic road network as well as the predicted future challenges, and to understand local and regional aspirations. Key to that is involving customers, neighbours, stakeholders and delivery partners. This process is open to EVERYONE so please feel free to share the information with others.
