YOUTH CLUB FOR OUR PARISH?

Prior to our Ordinary Meeting on Wednesday 19 February we welcomed Nick Smith who is the Chairman of Young People Cornwall. Nick gave an interesting talk on the work that Young People Cornwall do for our county. Their aim is to improve the quality of life for young people in Cornwall and they work to deliver inspirational youth work to support the needs and aspirations of young people within our county. They are funded through Children in Need, Comic Relief, Cornwall Council and The Rank Foundation. There are training programmes such as Build a Boat week, Football tournaments, media work, individual support, healthwatch Champions, GP Champions project using social media and Apps development.

We have invited the organisation to attend the May Day event. This will be a fantastic opportunity for residents to engage with the group and explore the opportunities that could be developed within our parish. We also wish to establish if the young people within our parish would be interested in engaging with this organisation. Finally we need to know if any adults would be able to help. There would be considerable backing from the organisation for any adults who would be interested in participating with the running of the youth club.
